Trout Fishing Regulation Updates for 2016

The State of Wisconsin Trout Fishing Regulations for the general open season for inland streams runs from the first Saturday in May at 5:00 am through October 15th.

The following State of Wisconsin Trout Fishing Regulations are applicable to anglers fishing Fort McCoy waters: there is no longer a length limit for trout in all Fort McCoy waters and a daily bag limit of five (5) with the exception of Silver Creek.

NOTE: Fort McCoy Special Regulation: Silver Creek from the bridge east of the airport downstream to the west boundary has a trout daily bag limit of three (3) and only artificial lures may be used. There is no minimum size.

All other waters	Trout	5	No minimum size	No lure restrictions (see live bait rules below)

Please remember while fishing on Fort McCoy it is illegal...

- to take, catch, kill or fish for any variety of fish in excess of the daily bag limit or total daily bag limit.
- to possess more than the possession limit at any time.
- to use **minnows** on any Fort McCoy waters except the North Flowage and Lost Lake.
- to use crayfish in any Fort McCoy waters.
- to possess any live bait, hooks or lures other than artificial lures while on the water, banks or shores of waters where only the use of artificial lures is allowed.
